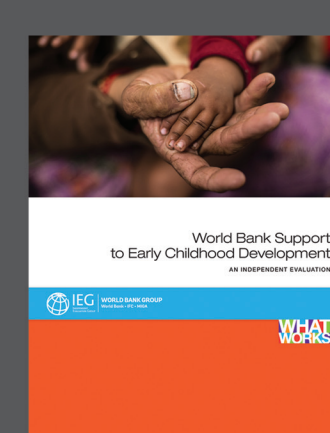
What works to improve children's development?
